WORKSHOPS

Build critical and creative thinking skills in students with an interactive workshop inspired by our current exhibitions. Drawing on contemporary art and artists' practices, students will follow an inquiry-based model of making and responding, with a creative output they can take home. Workshops can be paired with an exhibition tour to maximise learning outcomes.

ART ENQUIRER: WRITING ABOUT ART

Senior secondary students can immerse themselves in a critical art writing program presented in partnership with Flying Arts. Participants will delve into the art world and hone their critical thinking and written communication skills with studio visits and talks by artists, curators and arts industry professionals.

EDUCATION RESOURCES
